The Oakland A's beat the Orioles in the ALCS, three games to one. The two teams traded victories in Oakland, but the A's took the last two in Baltimore with 1-0 and 2-1 scores. During the regular schedule, The Birds and A's split their season series, 6-6.

Three-fourths of the Orioles' infield: Brooks Robinson, Mark Belanger, and Bobby Grich led the American League in assists at their respective positions...Grich led the O's in home runs (19) and runs scored (92). DH Tommy Davis topped the team in RBI (84) and base hits (181) while Grich was next with 82 runs batted in. Paul Blair popped 17 dingers, drove home 62 runs and scored seventy-seven... With a 22-10 record, starter Mike Cuellar was the Orioles' top winner on the pitching staff. Ross Grimsley (18) and Dave McNally (16) followed Cuellar in victories. Jim Palmer was an uncharacteristic 7-12 on the season. Grimsley would lead the staff in strikeouts (158). McNally struck out 111 batters...As a ball club, the Orioles hit .256 and 116 home runs while the staff's ERA was 3.27 with a league leading 15 shutouts. Cuellar led the hurlers with 20 complete games and five shutouts...The Birds edged the Yankees by two games to capture the AL East crown. The O's won the season series, 11-7.
