**The '74 Red Sox season--the prelude to the magical '75 campaign in Beantown--was sabotaged by two key injuries: Carlton Fisk was lost for the season June 28<sup>th</sup> when his left knee was torn up in a home plate collision; and Rick Wise (expected to be a big part of a very solid starting staff with Luis Tiant and Bill Lee) saw limited action with shoulder miseries and a broken finger. (Wise was 3-4 in wins and losses with a 3.86 ERA in 49 innings pitched.) The Boston's led the American League East by seven games August 23<sup>rd</sup>, but then went into a 14-24 tailspin to give up a lead they never could recover...Team leaders: Carl Yastrzemski and Rico Petrocelli each hit 15 home runs while "Yaz" was tops with 79 RBI, 155 base hits, 93 runs scored, and 25 doubles. (Petrocelli knocked in 76 runs.)...Luis Tiant led the hurlers with 22 victories, 176 K's, 25 complete games, and seven shutouts. Bill Lee was 17-15 with 96 strikeouts and 16 complete games. The Red Sox led the league with 71 complete games...Boston batters hit .264, 109 home runs and led the league with 236 doubles and 696 runs scored...The staff ERA was 3.72 for the season...A pilgrimage of just over 1.55 million fans--the most in the A.L.--entered Fenway Park to see their beloved ball club...Boston ended the season seven games in back of first place, Baltimore, who won the season series, 10-8. The Red Sox were 11-7 versus the arch-rival Yankees who finished five games ahead (2<sup>nd</sup>) in the standings.**
