*At the age of 18, "The Kid," Robin Yount, made his major league debut on Opening Day at County Stadium against the Red Sox. Yount was hitless in his first four games, but popped a game-winning homer in his sixth big league contest. He is the last major leaguer to hit a homer as an 18-year-old. Yount played for the Brewers for twenty years, but actually considered retiring in 1978 to play professional golf while in the midst of a contract dispute. (He would be inducted into baseball's Hall of Fame in 1999.)*

*George Scott (82 RBI) and Johnny Briggs (73 RBI) each hit seventeen taters to lead the ball club. Don Money popped 15 dingers, drove home sixty-five, and led the Brewers with 85 runs scored and 178 hits. Darrell Porter and Pedro Garcia both hit 12 homers...Number One starter Jim Slaton led the pitching staff with thirteen wins and 126 K's. Billy Champion was an eleven-game winner while both Jim Colborn and reliever Tom Murphy ended the year with ten victories. Clyde Wright was 9-20, but topped the hurlers with 15 complete games...As a team, Milwaukee hit .244, 120 home runs, and led the A.L. with 49 triples...The staff ERA was 3.76, eighth in the league... The Brewers finished the year 15 games in back of AL East champ, Baltimore, and beat the Orioles in the season series, 10-8.*
