*Team leaders: John Milner (20 homers, 63 RBI, 70 runs scored); "Rusty" Staub (19 home runs, 78 RBI, 145 base hits); Jerry Koosman (15 wins); Tom Seaver (201 strikeouts). Seaver was an even 11-11 for the season; Jon Matlack was 13-15 with 14 complete games and seven shutouts. Ray Sadecki finished 8-8 among the starters...Wayne Garrett and Cleon Jones each popped thirteen home runs. As a team, the Mets hit 96 homers and .235 at the plate. The staff ERA was 3.42 with 46 complete games and 14 saves--the latter last in the National League...New York wrapped up the season 17 games in back of division champion, Pittsburgh, who won the season series, 11-7, and 8 ½ games behind fourth place Montreal. Season attendance at Shea Stadium was a little over 1.72 million.*
