"Big Mac," Willie McCovey, led the team with 22 homers. He drove in sixty-three. Dave Winfield hit 20 home runs and was tops with 75 RBI, 132 base hits, and 57 runs scored. Nate Colbert added 14 homers and 54 RBI...Four pitchers: Bill Greif, Dave Freisleben, Dan Spillner, and Larry Hardy each won nine games to lead the pitching staff. Greif led the group with 137 strikeouts and seven complete games while future ace, lefthander Randy Jones, was 8-22 for the season. The staff's ERA was a league worst 4.58...Padres' batters were last in the N.L. with a .229 batting average and base hits (1,239). They clubbed 99 homers...New owner and McDonald's restaurant mogul, Ray Kroc, apologized to fans after the Padres' first home game (a 9-5 loss to Houston) via the P. A. system for the team's horrendous play that day. A "streaker" ran naked onto the field after this proclamation for which Kroc again used the microphone to yell: "Throw him in jail!!" The ball club was a disastrous 1-17 in the season series versus Atlanta...San Diego scored 541 runs (last in the N.L.) and allowed 830 runs to score (also last in the league).
