Willie Stargell led the 93rd edition of the Bucs with 25 home runs and 96 runs batted in--the latter second on the team. Richie Zisk popped 17 homers and was the team leader with 100 RBI. Richie Hebner contributed eighteen more dingers to the Pirates' total of 114 for the season. He scored a team high 97 runs. Al Oliver hit for a "triple double": 38 doubles, 12 triples, and 11 home runs. Oliver topped the ball club with 198 base hits. The team led the N.L. in hitting with a .274 average and 1,560 hits...Jerry Reuss (16 wins, 105 K's, 101 walks, and 14 complete games) led the pitching staff in victories. Jim Rooker won 15 games, completed fifteen and led the staff in strikeouts (139). Ken Brett was a 13-game winner; Dock Ellis won twelve. The staff ERA came in at 3.49 with a league leading 51 complete games...The Buccos won the NL East by just 1 ½ games over the Cardinals, but St. Louis won the season series, 11-7. The Dodgers would beat Pittsburgh in the NLCS, three games to one.
