The Halos finished just four games behind Oakland in the AL West while looking for their third straight division title...Tim Salmon, aka "Mr. Angel" and one of the most beloved Angels of all-time, concluded his career after sitting out the entire '05 season because of injury. He finished just one homer short of reaching 300 round-trippers for his career--entirely in Anaheim...Team leaders: "Vlad" Guerrero (33 homers, 116 RBI, 200 hits); Juan Rivera (23 dingers, 85 RBI); and Garrett Anderson (17 home runs, 85 RBI). Mike Napoli added 16 round-trippers while Orlando Cabrera led the ball club by scoring 95 runs for the year. The Angels hit a composite .274 and 159 home runs...Ervin Santana led the pitching staff with 16 victories. John Lackey posted a 13-11 W/L record and topped the staff with 190 K's. Santana had 141 strikeouts. Kelvim Escobar and Jered Weaver both won eleven. Closer Francisco Rodriguez whiffed 98 batters and finished 58 games. The Angels' staff ended third in the A.L. with a 4.04 ERA, allowed the fewest home runs (158) and racked up the most strikeouts (1,164)...Anaheim WON eleven of their eighteen games versus Oakland during the regular season.
