As of April 26th, the Giants had begun the season solely holding or tied for first place in the NL West with an 11-10 record. They would occupy the top, alone, one more time: July 22nd with a ½ game lead and a record of 51-47. They finished the season 11 ½ games out...Barry Bonds inched closer to Hank Aaron's all-time career home run record and tied for the team lead in round-trippers with Ray Durham (26). Durham (93 RBI) was second to Pedro Feliz's ninety-eight. Omar Vizquel tallied the most base hits (171) and runs scored (88). Feliz and Moises Alou both hit 22 home runs; Alou rang up 74 RBI. For the year, the Giants hit .259 and 163 homers...Matt Cain struck out 179 batters and led the pitching staff with thirteen victories. Jason Schmidt was an 11-game winner and topped the staff in strikeouts (180). Matt Morris was the victor of ten ball games. An ERA of 4.63 placed the Giants twelfth in the N. L. at seasons end...The soon-to-be popular Tim Lincecum was the Giants first selection and tenth overall in the 2006 amateur draft, June 6th.
