Leftfielder Jason Bay led the ball club with 35 homers, 109 RBI, and 101 runs scored. Jeromy Burnitz and Jose Bautista both followed with 16 home runs. Freddy Sanchez was the National League's batting champion and finished second on the team with 85 runs batted in despite cracking only six homers. He also had a team high 200 base hits. Second baseman Jose Castillo popped 14 dingers and drove home 65 runs. Craig Wilson had thirteen round-trippers...Starter Ian Snell was the leader of the pitching staff with 14 victories and 169 strikeouts. Zach Duke logged 10 wins, 117 punch outs, and the team's only two complete games...The Bucs went on to hit .263 for the season with 141 home runs--the latter the fewest in the league. The staff ERA was 4.52...Pittsburgh ended the season 16 ½ games behind the first place Cardinals in the NL Central with St. Louis winning the season series, 9-6. The Pirates WON three season series over the Cubs, Brewers, and Giants. It was the ball club's fourteenth consecutive losing season.
