At the season's mid-point, the "Brew Crew" was 40-41, in third place, and just 4 ½ games out of first. The closest they would come to the top spot of the NL Central would be 2 ½ games on July 6th. Two days later, the team dipped below .500 and remained there the rest of the year...Milwaukee finished fourteenth in the league with a .258 batting average and seventh with 180 home runs. Bill Hall smacked 35 homers, drove in 85, and scored 101 runs to lead the team. Both Prince Fielder and Carlos Lee (prior to the latter's trade) hit 28 home runs. Fielder had the most base hits (154)...The pitching staff was second from the bottom of the league with a 4.82 ERA. Dave Bush (166 K's) was a 12-game winner while Chris Capuano and Doug Davis--two lefties--both followed with eleven wins. Capuano was the staff leader in strikeouts (174)...The Brewers scored 730 runs for the season and gave up 833 to the opposition.
