One wonders how this team ever won a ball game...By the end of April, they had completed a free-fall to the cellar of the AL Central Division with a 5-17 mark and 11 games out of first place. The Royals suffered a thirteen-game losing streak, May 12<sup>th</sup> through May 25<sup>th</sup>...Mark Teahan hit 18 home runs, the most on the team. The other leaders: Emil Brown, 81 RBI; and Mark Grudzielanek, 163 base hits, 85 runs scored. K. C. hit 124 homers for the year ( LAST in the A. L.) and finished eleventh in the league with a .271 team batting average...The pitching staff ended a season-long horror show with a major league WORST 5.65 ERA. Somehow, Mark Redman topped the staff with eleven victories. Reliever Jimmy Gobble posted the most strikeouts (80). Redman was next with seventy-six. Luke Hudson won seven games to finish second in the pitching corps...For the year, the Royals totaled 757 runs scored and allowed 971 to cross home plate.
