Despite finishing twenty games behind NL West king Cincinnati, the Dodgers WON the season series, 10-8...With 25 home runs and 101 runs batted in, the Dodgers dependable and consistent third baseman, Ron Cey, led the ball club. He was nicknamed "Penguin" because of his choppy, waddling-type running style. Jimmy Wynn followed with 18 homers and 58 RBI. Steve Garvey hit 18 dingers as well and finished second to Cey with 95 runs batted in. Catcher Steve Yeager added 12 home runs...Staff ace Andy Messersmith topped the Dodger hurlers with 19 victories, 213 strikeouts, 19 complete games, and seven shutouts. Burt Hooton was 18-7 and completed twelve contests, including four shutouts. Don Sutton ended the year 16-13 in wins and losses; he punched out 175 batters. Lefty Doug Rau was 15-9 with 151 K's. The Dodger staff was tops in the N.L. in several categories: 2.92 ERA, fifty-one complete games, 17 shutouts, least runs allowed (534), and fewest bases on balls (448). They led the majors in ERA, least runs and bases on balls allowed. As a ball club, L. A. hit .248 and 118 home runs. They were second in steals with 138 for the year.
