The Giants finished 27 ½ games behind the NL West Champion Cincinnati Reds who won the season series, 13-5. The ball club hit .259 for the year, smacked 84 homers, and scored 659 runs. Gary Matthews was the team leader with 12 dingers followed by Bobby Murcer (11) and Chris Speier (10). Murcer was tops with 91 RBI. Next was Willie Montanez (85) and Speier (69). Von Joshua led the team in hits (161) while Derrel Thomas scored 99 times...Leading the pitching staff was John Montefusco with 15 wins and 215 strikeouts. Jim Barr won thirteen games and lefty Pete Falcone twelve. Falcone also had 131 punch outs. Big Ed Halicki won nine contests and struck out one hundred fifty-three. The staff ERA was 3.74 and allowed 671 runs for the season...The Giants drew just under 523,000 fans to Candlestick Park, last in the National League.
