Another terrific Dodgers ball club which drew 2.1 million fans to Chavez Ravine and finished just 3 ½ games behind the NL West champion Reds...Joe Ferguson led the team with 25 homers, 88 RBI, and 84 runs scored. Add Willie Davis's 16 home runs and 77 RBI as well as Ron Cey's 15 dingers and 80 RBI--that's a pretty potent outfit. Davis had the team high in base hits (171). As a team, the Dodgers slammed 110 home runs and batted .263 for the season--the latter second in the National League...Number One starter Don Sutton topped the pitching staff with 18 wins, 200 strikeouts, and 14 complete games. Claude Osteen and Tommy John were both 16-game winners while Andy Messersmith came in with a 14-10 W/L record and 177 K's...The Dodger staff had the league's best ERA (3.00) and finished second in strikeouts (961)...Dodger hurlers completed 45 games with 13 shutouts...Davis won his third straight Gold Glove Award; "3-Dog" has been one of the game's best centerfield fly-chasers in Dodger Blue since 1960...L. A. won seven of eighteen games in the season series with Cincinnati.
