**The Reds battled through some batting slumps and pitching shorts, but still beat the Dodgers for the NL West title by 3 ½ games...The acquisition of starter Fred Norman from the Padres, June 12<sup>th</sup>, was a big key to the Reds' surge to the division title...Pete Rose led the National League with 230 hits, posted the league's top batting average, AND was voted the senior circuit's MVP...The Mets, however, beat the Redlegs in the NLCS, three games to two...Team leaders: Tony Perez (27 homers, 101 RBI, 177 base hits); Johnny Bench (25 home runs, 104 RBI); Jack Billingham (19 wins, 155 strikeouts, 16 complete games, seven shutouts). Joe Morgan popped 26 homers, drove home eighty-two, and had a team high 116 runs scored. Rose crossed the plate 115 times...Don Gullett was 18-8 with 153 punch outs. Norman posted 12 victorles with the Reds... The ball club hit 137 homers and .254 for the season. The staff ERA was 3.40 with a league leading 15 shutouts. The Reds won the season series with the pennant-winning Mets, 8-4.**
