First baseman Lee May led the ball club with 28 homers and 105 runs batted in. Young super star Cesar Cedeno clobbered 25 home runs and drove home seventy. Bob Watson contributed 16 homers along with 94 RBI while Doug Rader socked 21 dingers and drove home eighty-nine. Watson had team highs in base hits (179) and runs scored (97). Jimmy Wynn blasted 20 homers and collected 55 RBI. Cedeno finished third in the league in stolen bases... Pitching leaders: Dave Roberts (17 wins, 119 K's, 12 complete games) and Jerry Reuss (16 victories, 177 strikeouts, 117 bases on balls, 12 complete games). Don Wilson won ten games and Ken Forsch nine. The latter two both struck out 149 batters...The staff ERA was 3.75...The Astros hit .251 with 134 home runs for the season...Houston won seven of eighteen games and finished eleven behind division champion Cincinnati.
