The Brewers may have turned a corner in '73 looking like a team on the rise. They hit .253 for the season and 145 home runs, the latter fifth in the American League. George "Boomer" Scott led the ball club with 98 runs scored and 107 runs batted in. He hit 24 homers. Centerfielder Dave May was the home run leader with twenty-five and was second to Scott with 93 RBI and 96 runs scored. He also led the ball club with 189 base hits. Johnny Briggs added 18 dingers; Darrell Porter hit sixteen; Pedro Garcia and Bob Coluccio both contributed fifteen. Garcia hit a team high 32 doubles...Jim Colborn won 20 games, struck out 135 batters, completed 22 games, and threw four shutouts to lead the pitching staff. Jim Slaton was 13-15 with 134 K's and 13 complete games. Jerry Bell and Eduardo Rodriguez both finished with nine wins. The staff's ERA was 3.98...The Brewers finished the year 23 games behind AL East champion Baltimore. Milwaukee won only THREE of eighteen games from the Orioles during the regular season.

Robin Yount, a future Hall of Famer, was drafted with the Brewers' first pick (third overall) in baseball's 1973 Amateur Draft.
