Team leaders from "Parc Jarry": Bob Bailey (26 homers, 86 RBI); Ken Singleton (23 home runs, 103 RBI, 169 base hits, 100 runs scored); and utilityman Hal Breeden (15 homers, 43 RBI). Expos' batters hit .251 and 125 homers for the season...Steve Renko was the pitching staff's leader with 15 wins and 164 K's. He completed nine games. Steve Rogers won ten games with 64 strikeouts and a team high three shutouts. Balor Moore was second with 151 punch outs. He posted seven victories. Closer Mike Marshall whiffed 124 batters and won fourteen. The staff's ERA was 3.71...In a weak NL East Division, the Expos wound down their fifth season 3 ½ games behind the Mets; the two rivals split their season series, 9-9. Mike Jorgensen was awarded a Gold Glove at the same time his boss, skipper Gene Mauch, was named the league's Manager of the Year. Just over 1.2 million fans clicked the turnstiles to see Les Expos, the hometown team.
