Bobby Bonds led the ninety-first edition of the NY/SF Giants franchise with 39 homers, 96 RBI, 131 runs scored, and 34 doubles. Right behind was Willie McCovey who slammed 29 home runs and drove home seventy-five. Garry Maddox contributed 76 runs batted in and a team high 187 base hits. Dave "Kong" Kingman socked 24 dingers and drove home fifty-five. As a team, the Giants hit .262 (3rd in the league), 161 homers (2nd), 52 triples (1st in the majors), and stole 112 bases (2nd)...Staff ace Ron Bryant had a terrific year: twenty-four victories (tied with the White Sox' Wilbur Wood for the most in the majors) but a meager 143 K's to lead the hurlers. Tom Bradley won thirteen with 136 strikeouts. Jim Barr and Juan Marichal both won eleven games. The latter posted a team-leading nine complete games. Giants' hurlers compiled a 3.79 ERA and the fewest strikeouts in the league (787). They topped the N.L. in saves (44)...San Francisco finished eleven games behind the NL West champion Cincinnati Reds with the Redlegs winning the season's match-ups, 10-8. The Giants won ten of twelve contests versus the Cubs.
