On July 20<sup>th</sup>, Wilbur Wood, regarded as one of the best knuckleball pitchers the game has seen, became the last major leaguer to start **BOTH** ends of a doubleheader in the 20<sup>th</sup> Century...and LOSE BOTH games. The event (which likely will never occur again) came against the Yankees in New York...On May 26<sup>th</sup>, he pitched the final five innings of a 21-inning suspended game against the Indians AND THEN pitched a complete game shutout (allowing only four hits) in Chicago's next regularly scheduled contest, May 28<sup>th</sup>. He was the winning pitcher in BOTH games played at Comiskey Park...Bill Melton and Carlos May both led the ball club with 20 homers. May was tops with 96 RBI and Melton was second with eighty-seven. Melton led the Sox in base hits (155), runs scored (83), and doubles (29). Dick Allen suffered a broken leg in June but still posted a solid 20 doubles, 16 home runs, and 41 runs batted in while playing in only 72 games...For the season, the red-pinstriped White Sox hit .256 and 111 homers. They were caught stealing 73 times in 156 attempts--the worst number in the league...Wilbur Wood led the pitching staff with a 24-20 won/loss record including 21 complete games and 199 K's. Stan Bahnsen won eighteen contests and completed fourteen. Closer Cy Acosta was a ten-game winner out of the bullpen. The staff's ERA was 3.86...The White Sox finished the year seventeen games behind first place, Oakland, who won the season series, 12-6. They were 13-5 versus Texas.
