Team leaders: Bobby Murcer (33 home runs, 96 RBI, 171 base hits and a league leading 102 runs scored); Ron Blomberg (14 homers, 49 RBI); and Roy White (10 home runs, 54 RBI). As a team, the Yanks hit .249 (2nd in the A.L.) and 103 homers for the season... "Fritz" Peterson (100 K's) led the pitching staff with 17 wins and 12 complete games. Steve Kline was 16-9 and completed eleven contests. Number One starter Mel Stottlemyre finished the season 14-18 with a staff leading 110 strikeouts and seven shutouts. Mike Kekich posted a 10-13 won/loss record. "Sparky" Lyle's 35 saves were the most in the league. The staff put up a 3.05 ERA and were third in the A.L. with 39 saves...New York ended the season 6 ½ games in back of division champion, Detroit, but "The Bombers" won the season series, 9-7. The Yankees split with the Red Sox, 9-9...Felipe Alou reached 2,000 career hits and 200 home runs during the '72 season... The Number Eight, worn by a pair of Yankee greats, catchers Bill Dickey and Yogi Berra, was retired.
