The Expos drew just over 1.14 million to Parc Jarry to root on the team that is slowly but gradually improving...Montreal finished 26 ½ games behind the NL East Champion, Pirates, and eleven games ahead of the bottom-feeding Phillies. Les Expos were 6-12 against the Bucs and 10-8 versus the Phils...Team leaders: Ron Fairly (17 homers, 68 RBI); Bob Bailey (16 home runs, 57 RBI); and Ken Singleton (14 homers, 50 runs batted in). Singleton led the team with 77 runs scored and 139 base hits...Mike Torrez was tops on the pitching staff with a nice 16 victories while Bill Stoneman added 12 wins and led the hurlers with 171 strikeouts. Stoneman also pitched his second career no-hitter on October 2nd against the Mets in the first game of a twin-bill at Montreal. The 7-0 game was the first major league no-no pitched outside the United States...Closer Mike Marshall was a 14-game winner and led the league in games pitched (65) and games finished (52). He struck out 95 batters...Balor Moore whiffed 161 opponents...Future Expos' stars Ellis Valentine and Gary Carter were taken in the amateur draft in the second and third rounds, respectively... "Rusty" Staub was traded to the Mets on April 5th... Montreal hit .234 as a team with 91 homers. The staff ERA was 3.59...Denny Lemaster closed out his career, June 21st, against the Reds at Cincinnati in a 6-4 loss.
