Hall of Fame broadcaster Ernie Harwell was certainly happy that his Tigers led the American League with 179 home runs. "The TYGS" as he liked to call them, hit .254 as a team-- good for third place in the league. Norm Cash led the ball club with 32 home runs and 91 RBI. Willie Horton was next with 22 homers and 72 runs batted in. Catcher Bill Freehan clobbered 21 home runs...Mickey Lolich topped the pitching corps with 25 wins, 308 strikeouts, and a whopping 29 complete games. His number of K's and complete games led the league. What's more, Lolich became only the SECOND pitcher in baseball history to win twenty-five and NOT win the Cy Young Award. Joe Coleman was second on the staff with 20 wins, 236 strikeouts, and 16 complete games. The Tiger hurlers were the league leaders with 1,000 strikeouts...Detroit ended the campaign 12 games behind AL East Champ, Baltimore, but the Tigers won ten of the eighteen regular season games they played versus the Orioles...Al Kaline posted 15 home runs and 54 runs batted in...Staff ERA: 3.63.
