The Brewers' second full season at County Stadium ended in a last place finish in the AL West, 32 games behind division champ Oakland. Bud Selig's ball club DID win FOUR season series: from the Angels (12-6), the Indians (8-4), the Twins (10-7), and the Royals (10-8). Milwaukee won just three of eighteen games from the A's...Team leaders: John Briggs (21 homers, 59 RBI); Dave May (16 home runs, 65 RBI); Marty Pattin (14 wins, 169 K's). Bill Parsons, second in the A.L.'s Rookie of the Year voting, won thirteen contests. Closer Ken Sanders led the league in saves, games pitched, and with 77 games finished. The pitching staff's ERA was 3.38. As a team, the Brewers hit .229, LAST in the A.L. (the league average was .247), and 104 homers (8th).
