"The Big Red Machine" hit a speed bump in '71 (their ONLY losing season in the decade of the 1970s), but the momentum continued to build to produce some of the BEST ball clubs of ALL TIME. Manager George "Sparky" Anderson is gaining the reputation of being referred to as "Captain Hook" with his penchant for quickly yanking and utilizing several pitchers during a game...Lee May led the Redlegs with 39 home runs and 98 RBI. Johnny Bench would launch 27 homers and knock in 61 runs, but he didn't come close to matching his 1970 MVP statistics at the plate. Bench hit 18 fewer home runs, drove in 87 fewer runs, and his batting average was 55 points lower in '71 when compared to the year prior. Tony Perez slammed 25 dingers while driving in ninety-one. Pete Rose led the team in hits (192) and runs scored (86), all down from 1970. His batting average was twelve points lower than the year before. George Foster assumed regular duties in the outfield for the first time but only added 10 home runs and fifty RBI...The pitching DID appear to be solid. Lefty Don Gullett led the hurlers with a 16-6 record. Gary Nolan (12-15) topped the staff with 146 strikeouts and nine complete games. Lefthanded starter Ross Grimsley won ten contests while Clay Carroll also posted ten victories out of the bullpen...The Redlegs hit 138 homers (4th in the N.L.) and .241 (9th in the N.L.) for the season...In '71, they hit 53 fewer homers and the team batting average was 29 points lower than in 1970...The staff ERA, 3.35, was good for seventh in the league.
