The D-Backs sprinted out of the gate winning 20 of their first 28 games and had built a nice separation from the competition in the NL West. The ball club was 11-17 in May and 47-48 by the All Star break. The hitting had begun to steadily tail off and the pitching (other than Brandon Webb, Dan Haren and Randy Johnson) became unreliable. They finally fell out of contention for a post-season spot after a 12-3 loss, September 25th, to St. Louis. The D-Backs would end the year two games behind the NL West champ Dodgers who won the season series, 10-8...Webb, the Number One starter, won his first nine starts and led the pitching staff with 22 wins. Dan Haren was a 16-game winner and topped the staff with 206 K's. Randy Johnson won eleven. Max Scherzer made his major league debut and retired the first 13 batters he faced, all in relief. The staff ERA was 3.98...Mark Reynolds led the team with 28 home runs and 97 RBI. Stephen Drew posted a "triple double" with 44 doubles, 11 triples, and 21 homers. He led the D-Backs in hits (178) and runs scored (91). Chris Young had 22 dingers and 85 RBI. Late season pick-up (TOO late the fans said), power hitter Adam Dunn, added eight homers and 26 RBI. Arizona hit .251 and 159 home runs for the year. Their 47 triples led the N.L.
