Rookie skipper Brad Ausmus directed the Tigers to their fourth consecutive AL Central title. The ball club was in first place for 162 days of the season but needed a win, 3-0, over Minnesota on the last day to clinch the division crown. In the post-season, however, the Tigers were eliminated by the Orioles, three games to none, in the AL Division Series. It ended a streak of three straight trips to the American League Championship Series...The pitching staff ended the year tenth in the A.L. with a 4.01 ERA. Ace Max Scherzer posted a record of 18-5 and struck out 14 Pirates in a game on August 14th. He led the team and was third in the majors in strikeouts (252). Scherzer whiffed 10.294 batters per nine innings pitched. Justin Verlander had an uncharacteristic "off year" while battling arm ailments most of the campaign. He was 15-12 with 159 K's. Rick Porcello had a record of 15-13 and topped the staff with three complete games and three shutouts...DH Victor Martinez led the Tigers with 32 home runs and was second in RBI (103). Miguel Cabrera was the team leader with 109 runs batted in and was second in homers (25). Cabrera led the Tigers in base hits (191) and runs scored (101). Detroit posted the league's highest batting average (.277) and finished fourth with 155 home runs. They scored 757 runs, second in the A.L.
