The Nats clinched the NL East Division title on September 16<sup>th</sup> with a 3-0 win over the Braves, their second crown in three years. They finished the season with the best record in the National League and by 17 games over the Braves and Mets who tied for second. Matt Williams, the rookie skipper, was named Manager of the Year in the N.L.... Adam LaRoche led the ball club with 26 homers and 92 RBI. Ian Desmond followed with 24 home runs and 91 RBI. Denard Span topped the team in hits (184) while Anthony Rendon had the team high in runs scored (111). The Nats hit .253 and 152 homers... Doug Fister's 16-6 record topped the pitching staff. Stephen Strasburg (14-11) led the staff with 242 strikeouts. Righty Tanner Roark won 15 ball games. Jordan Zimmermann (14-5) pitched a no-hitter the last day of the season, a 1-0 game at Nationals Park against Miami. He struck out ten, walked one, and had two hits at the plate in the no-no... The staff led the N.L. with a 3.03 ERA... They were eliminated from the playoffs by the future World Champion Giants, three games to one, in the NLDS.
