At the end of April, the Blue Jays were 12-15 and 3 ½ games out of first place. When the calendar turned to May they took off. They were 21-9 (including a nine-game winning streak) for the month and held first place on May 22nd. From June 7th to June 30th, however, the Jays were 7-15 and lost their momentum...The Jays hit .259 for the year and were second in the A.L. with 177 homers. Jose Bautista led the team with 35 home runs, 103 RBI, and 101 runs scored. Edwin Encarnacion (who socked a record 16 home runs in May alone) launched 34 dingers and drove in ninety-eight. Jose Reyes led the ball club with 175 hits...R. A. Dickey topped the pitching staff with 14 wins; Drew Hutchison whiffed 184 batters to lead the pitching staff. Dickey was second with 173 strikeouts. Mark Buehrle was 13-10, Hutchison (11-13), and J. A. Happ (11-11). The smallish, talented, and hard-throwing Marcus Stroman was a sparkling 11-6 with 111 K's. The staff ended the year with a 4.00 ERA...The Jays would finish 13 games behind the AL East champion Orioles who won their season series, 11-8.
