The Braves were tied for first in the NL East as late as July 20th, but September was a washout: A 4-16 record dropped them 17 games behind the front-running Nationals and into a second place tie with the Mets at the season's conclusion...The Braves were eleventh in the N.L. with a .241 batting average and 123 home runs. Team leaders: Justin Upton (29 homers, 102 RBI) and catcher/fan fave Evan Gattis (22 dingers). Freddie Freeman led the team in hits (175), runs scored (93), and was second with 78 RBI. He also clubbed 18 homers...Julio Teheran and Ervin Santana both won 14 games to lead the pitching staff. The former racked up the most strikeouts (179). Aaron Harang (12) and Alex Wood (11) followed the leaders in wins. Wood went on to strike out 170 batters. Super Closer Craig Kimbrel finished 54 games and claimed 95 strikeout victims. The staff was third in the league with a very respectable 3.38 ERA. They were fourth in strikeouts with a combined 1,301 for the year.
