The "Brew Crew" led the NL Central for most of the '14 season. They would spend 159 days in first place to as late as August 31st. At the All Star break, the ball club was 53-43 and one game in the lead of the division. As the NL Central kingpin, their biggest bulge had been 6 ½ games and as many as nineteen games over .500 in late June. On September 7th, they had dropped to third place and five games out with a 74-69 record. The Brewers would get no closer than four games to first place again...Ryan Braun's power numbers dropped off greatly partly due to a suspension he served for most of the second half of 2013. His suspension was for the use of an illegal substance to enhance his performance. He had previously denied any wrongdoing. Carlos Gomez led the team with 23 home runs and 95 runs scored. He was second with 73 RBI. Braun, in 134 games, clubbed 19 dingers and topped the Brewers with 81 RBI. Mark Reynolds and Khris Davis both hit 22 homers. Jonathan Lucroy led the team in hits (176) and doubles (53). Milwaukee hit .250 for the year and 150 home runs...Wily Peralta was the leader of the pitching staff with 17 wins and 154 K's. Righty Kyle Lohse finished 13-9 and topped the hurlers with two complete games and two shutouts. He struck out 141 batters. Yovani Gallardo and Matt Garza both won eight contests. Closer Frankie Rodriguez tied for third in the N.L. in saves. Reliever Will Smith whiffed 86 batters. The staff ended the season tenth in the league with a 3.67 ERA.
