Expectations were high going into the season but the team didn't produce timely hits when needed while the bullpen was unpredictable. The Phils also decided to stick with veteran players being paid huge contracts who greatly underperformed...Marlon Byrd led the team in homers (25). Ryan Howard (23 dingers) had a team high 95 RBI. Ben Revere led the ball club in hits (184); Jimmy Rollins scored the most runs (78). The Phils batted .242 and hit 125 homers...Kyle Kendrick's ten wins led the pitching staff. Cole Hamels (9-9) struck out 198 batters to lead the team. Free agent pick-up A. J. Burnett was a welcome veteran addition to the staff but finished 8-18 with 190 strikeouts. Two other pitchers won six games. Jonathan Papelbon was a regular subject in trade talk all season. The staff ERA was twelfth in the N.L. (3.79).
