The Rays got off to a rough start of the 2014 season. At the end of June their record was 36-49 placing them in fifth in the AL East 9 ½ games from first. Matt Moore missed most of the season after undergoing "Tommy John" surgery, one of numerous injuries that plagued the Rays during the year. Jeremy Hellickson returned in July after surgery to remove bone chips from his right elbow in February, but he wasn't as sharp as usual. Ace David Price was moved to the Tigers at the trading deadline when it appeared the Rays would not reach the post-season...Evan Longoria led the ball club with 22 homers and 91 RBI. He tied Ben Zobrist for the most runs scored (83). Zobrist and Desmond Jennings both followed with ten dingers. James Loney (nine homers) had the team high in base hits (174). He drove home sixty-nine. The Rays would hit .247 for the season and 117 homers...Price and Jake Odorizzi both led the pitching staff with 11 wins. Price, during his abbreviated time with the Rays, led the staff for the year in strikeouts (189). Two hard-throwers, Chris Archer and Alex Cobb both won ten ball games. The staff ERA was 3.56...MGR Joe Maddon and bench coach Dave Martinez left to fill those spots with the Cubs in 2015.
