During the off-season, the Yankees acquired former Red Sox centerfielder Jacoby Ellsbury and Japanese hurler Masahiro Tanaka. On May 12th, Tanaka would lose his FIRST game as a pro since 2012 to the Cubs. He also spent time on the disabled list along with starters Michael Pineda, C C Sabathia, and Ivan Nova. The latter two were later lost for the majority of the season...Injuries as well as a light-hitting offense derailed a run for the pennant. The Yankees hit .245 (eleventh in the A.L.) and 147 homers, well down from the usual output. Brian McCann led the Yanks with 23 homers and 75 RBI. Ellsbury (16 dingers) led the ball club in hits (156). Brett Gardner (17 homers) scored the most runs (87). Mark Teixeira blasted 22 home runs...Derek Jeter retired after the 2014 season. His last hit in his final at bat was a walk-off infield RBI single. A fabulous career. RE2PECT...Tanaka led the pitching staff with 13 wins while Hiroki Kuroda was the leader with 146 strikeouts. Tanaka had 141 K's. Mid-season pick-up Brandon McCarthy contributed seven wins. Reliever Dellin Betances whiffed 135 batters. David Robertson, who inherited the closer's role, struck out ninety-six. The staff ERA was 3.75...The Yankees missed the post-season for the second straight year and the third in the previous twenty.
