The Redlegs were back in the playoffs for the second straight season. On September 23rd, the Nationals lost a ball game to Saint Louis which vaulted the Reds into the NL Wild Card Game opposite the Pirates. At the same time, they became the first team that finished **THIRD** in the standings to make the post-season...The team leader in home runs and RBI was Jay Bruce who hit 30 dingers, 43 doubles, and drove in 109 runs. Joey Votto socked 24 home runs, led the Reds with 177 base hits, and played in all 162 regular season games. Shin-Soo Choo added 21 homers and led the ball club with 107 runs scored. Cincinnati ended the year eighth in the N.L with a .249 batting average and seventh after hitting 155 home runs...The pitching staff boasted **THREE** fourteen-game winners: Mat Latos, Bronson Arroyo, and Mike Leake. Homer Bailey, who won eleven, led the staff with 199 K's. Latos was next with 187 punch outs. Closer Aroldis Chapman had 112 strikeout victims. Bailey no-hit the Giants, July 2nd, in Cincinnati, missing a perfect game with a walk in the sixth inning. He struck out nine batters during his second career "no-no." The staff ERA finished fourth in the league (3.38) and was first with 1,296 strikeouts...The Reds spent ten days in first place in early April before dropping to third for most of the season. At the All Star break their record was 53-42 leaving them five games out of first place...Pittsburgh would win their Wild Card Game at PNC Park, 6-2.
