The multi-talented Carlos Gomez led the “Brew Crew” with 24 home runs including 10 triples and 27 doubles. He was second on the ball club in stolen bases and tied Nori Aoki for the team high with 80 runs scored. The top RBI man was catcher Jonathan Lucroy with eighty-two. Lucroy was second on the team with 18 homers. Jean Segura was the team leader with 173 base hits and in stolen bases. He tallied 10 triples as well. For the year, the ball club hit .252 and 157 home runs...Yovani Gallardo’s 12-10 record was the team’s best as well as his 144 strikeouts. Kyle Lohse and Wily Peralta each posted 11 victories apiece. The Number Four starter, Marco Estrada, was a seven-game winner. Closer Jim Henderson rang up 75 K’s. The staff ended the year ninth in the N.L with a 3.84 ERA...After May, the team got no closer than 15 games to first place.
