The Twins avoided finishing in last place for the first time since 2010...As a team, batters struck out a whopping 1,430 times...Catcher Joe Mauer was the American League's starting back stop in the All Star Game and received the A.L.'s Silver Slugger Award for his offensive excellence. He hit 11 home runs and led the ball club in base hits (144) and doubles (35). Brian Dozier (18 homers, 66 RBI, 72 runs scored) and Justin Morneau (17 home runs, 74 RBI) were the other team leaders at the plate. Four players hit fourteen home runs each: Trevor Plouffe, Josh Willingham, Ryan Doumit, and Oswaldo Arcia. The ball club hit .242 and 151 home runs...Kevin Correia (9 wins) topped the pitching staff. He and Mike Pelfrey (five wins) were tied with 101 strikeouts. Sam Deduno was 8-8 in wins/losses while Scott Diamond and Brian Duensing both won six games. Closer Glen Perkins (77 K's) was ninth in the A.L. in saves. The staff ERA was 4.55...At mid-season, the Twins were 36-45 and eight games out in fourth place.
