Team leaders: Adam Dunn led the White Sox with 34 homers and 86 runs batted in. Sox broadcaster Ken Harrelson nicknamed Dunn "Biggin'". The big guy also struck out a ridiculous 189 times! Alejandro De Aza followed with 17 dingers and 62 RBI. De Aza also led the ball club with 84 runs scored. As a team, the Sox hit .249 and 148 home runs...The tall and lean Chris Sale, the new ace of the pitching staff, was the leader with eleven wins and 226 K's. The up-and-coming (and talented) Jose Quintana appeared to be a top of the rotation starter who finished the year 9-7 racking up 164 strikeouts. The staff ERA was 3.98...The White Sox completed the season 30 games in back of A. L. Central champ, Detroit, and three games behind fifth place Minnesota. Chicago won seven of the nineteen games versus the Tigers; they were 8-11 against the Twins.
