The Dodgers got off to a great start and held first place (alone or in a tie) of the NL West for 68 days they were scheduled to play. Two pitchers who were big free-agent signings, Randy Wolf and Jason Schmidt, missed a good deal of time due to injury. Three youngsters: James Loney, Matt Kemp, and Russell Martin came through spectacularly. (Martin was named to his first All Star Team.) The ball club lost its head-of-steam and dropped to third place, August 3rd. They were only three games out of first on September 4th but faded once again....Jeff Kent led the team with 20 homers. Martin slugged 19 dingers and drove in 87. Juan Pierre was the high-man with 196 base hits and 96 runs scored...Brad Penny's 16-4 W/L record topped the pitching staff. He struck out 135. Both Derek Lowe and swing-man Chad Billingsley won twelve ball games. Lowe's 147 strikeouts were the most of any hurler. Billingsley produced 141 K's...The Dodgers hit a composite .275 and 129 homers. The staff ERA was 4.20.
