The defending World Champions muddled through a year in which they hovered around .500 the entire season. Injuries and performances below-the-norm compared to other seasons held the Cards back in '07. They did not spend a day in first place and were as many as 10 ½ games behind the division leader...Albert Pujols enjoyed his usual campaign by leading the ball club in home runs (32) and RBI (103). Chris Duncan followed with 20 dingers and 70 RBI. For the year, the Redbirds hit .274 and 141 home runs...Adam Wainwright led the pitching staff with a 14-12 won/loss record and 136 strikeouts. Braden Looper was 12-12 for the season. The staff ERA was 4.65... The Cards finished seven games behind the NL Central champion Cubs who won the season series, 11-5. The longest winning streak for the year was five games.
