Oakland finished the year 18 games behind the AL West champion Angels, but the A's won their season series, ten games to nine. As late as May 8th, the ball club was tied for first place with a record of 16-15. The large majority of the campaign found them locked in the third spot...After losing big-bopper Frank Thomas to free-agency, the A's would hit .256 (13th) and 171 homers (7th). Jack Cust topped the team with 26 home runs and 82 RBI. Shannon Stewart led with 167 base hits. Nick Swisher and Mark Ellis shared the lead for runs scored (84)...Oakland lost pitcher Barry Zito to free-agency as well, but the staff was sixth in the A.L. with a 4.28 ERA. Dan Haren was victorious in 15 games to lead the hurlers, including his 192 strikeouts. Joe Blanton won fourteen; Chad Gaudin was an eleven-game winner. Blanton also completed three ball games.
