Young super-star Vladimir Guerrero, only twenty-three, was the Expos leader with thirty-eight home runs, 109 RBI, 202 base hits, and 108 runs scored. He committed seventeen errors in rightfield but his bazooka-like throwing arm kept many an adventurous base-runner from taking any advantage. Shane Andrews followed with twenty-five homers. Brad Fullmer (13 home runs) was second on the team with 73 RBI and was tops with 44 doubles. Montreal hit .249 for the year (14th in the N.L.) and 147 homers which placed them eleventh. They scored the fewest runs (644)...Dustin Hermanson (14-11 wins/losses) was the only pitcher to win in double-digits. He led the staff with 154 strikeouts. Montreal was ninth in the league in ERA (4.38); they allowed 783 runs to score (10th)...Attendance at Stade Olympique was LAST in the major leagues-just under 915,000. They were the only ball club NOT to draw at least one million in '98.
