Watch those Redbirds FLY around the base paths...The Cards hit .252 for the season and led the N.L with 220 stolen bases. They hit 75 home runs. Team leaders: David Green (15 homers, 65 RBI); Darrell Porter (11 home runs, 68 RBI); George Hendrick (9 homers, 69 RBI). Willie McGee led the team in hits (166) and runs scored (82)...Number one starter Joaquin Andujar led the Cards AND the National League with 20 wins, innings pitched, and four shutouts. Andujar topped the Cardinals staff with 12 complete games and was awarded a Gold Glove along with shortstop Ozzie Smith. Lefty Dave LaPoint went 12-10 with 130 K's. Closer Bruce Sutter set a league record (at that time) in saves; he struck out 77 batters. The staff ERA was 3.58...The Cards finished 12 ½ games behind division champ Chicago. St. Louis won only five of eighteen games between the two NL East arch-rivals...The LAST season the Cardinals wore the very stylish and popular "Columbia Blue" road uniforms.
