First baseman Kevin Young was the team leader with 27 homers and 108 runs batted in. Jose Guillen was next with 14 dingers and 84 RBI. Catcher Jason Kendall--who sometimes hit leadoff--hit twelve homers, drove in seventy-five, and led the Bucs with 88 runs. Al Martin also banged out 12 dingers while Tony Womack led the ball club with 185 hits. The Pirates led the N.L in stolen bases (159). They hit .254 as a team and 107 homers...Francisco Cordova led the pitching staff with 13 wins, three complete games, and two shutouts. He struck out 157 batters. Jason Schmidt won eleven games and led the staff with 158 K's. Jon Lieber and Chris Peters both won eight contests. Reliever Mike Williams whiffed 59 batters. The staff ERA was sixth in the league at 3.91...At season's end, the Pirates were 33 games behind division champion, Houston, who won the season series, 9-2. The Bucs easily handled the cross-state rival, Phillies, winning that season series, 8-1.
