Brian Giles was the team leader with 39 homers, 115 RBI, and 109 runs scored. Kevin Young contributed 26 homers, 106 RBI, 103 runs and a team high 174 base hits. Al Martin slammed 24 dingers and drove in eighty-three while Ed Sprague--the Bucs lone All Star--ended the year with 22 home runs and 81 RBI. Catcher Jason Kendall suffered a horrific dislocated ankle injury at first base trying to beat out a bunt on July 4th against the Brewers. He was lost for the season. As a team, the Buccos hit .259 and 171 home runs...Todd Ritchie led the pitching staff with 15 wins. Jason Schmidt was 13-10 and topped the staff with 148 strikeouts. Kris Benson won eleven contests and struck out 139 batters. Closer Mike Williams whiffed seventy-six. Francisco Cordova finished 8-10 and had 98 K's. The staff ERA was 4.33, sixth in the N.L... Pittsburgh ended the season 18 ½ games behind NL Central champ Houston against whom the Bucs were 7-5 in the season series.
