The Bucs would be missing one of their most popular and best players in '05: Jason Kendall had been traded to Kansas City in November 2004...All Star Jason Bay was the team leader with 32 home runs, 101 RBI, 44 doubles, 183 base hits and 110 runs scored. Daryle Ward followed with 12 dingers and 63 RBI. Jose Castillo added 11 home runs. The Buccos were ninth in the N.L. in hitting (.259) and twelfth in homers (139)...Starter David Williams topped the pitching staff with 10 victories. The staff leader in strikeouts was Kip Wells (132). Williams struck out eighty-eight. Both Wells and lefty Zach Duke won eight contests. Oliver Perez posted just seven wins and whiffed 97 batters. The staff ERA was 4.42, eleventh in the league...Managers' records: Lloyd McClendon (55-81), Pete Mackanin (12-14). Mackanin moved into the manager's office, September 6th.
