Craig Wilson led the Bucs with 29 home runs and 97 runs scored. He was tied with Jason Bay (26 homers) for the team lead with 82 RBI. Rob Mackowiak added 17 dingers and 75 RBI to the offense. Shortstop Jack Wilson, the Bucs only All Star, hit for a "triple double": 41 doubles, 12 triples, and 11 homers. Wilson led the ball club in hits (201) and scored 82 times. Daryle Ward popped 15 taters and totaled 57 RBI. For the year, the Pirates hit .260 and 142 home runs...Number One starter Oliver Perez led the pitching staff with 12 wins and 239 strikeouts. Josh Fogg was an eleven-game winner while Kris Benson was 8-8. The staff ERA was 4.29, tenth in the N.L....The Pirates finished 32 ½ games behind NL Central champion St. Louis who won their season series, 12-5.
