New Phillies' star Scott Rolen not only won a Gold Glove Award for his outstanding defense, he led the Phils with 31 homers, 110 RBI, and 120 runs scored. He was second on the ball club with 174 hits. Doug Glanville led the team with 189 hits; he was second to Rolen after crossing the plate 106 times. Rightfielder Bobby Abreu clubbed 17 homers and drove home seventy-four. He gunned down 17 baserunners with his rifle arm. The Phillies hit .264 and 126 home runs for the year...Ace Curt Schilling led the pitching staff with 15 wins and the N.L. with 300 strikeouts. Schilling also led the league with 15 complete games. He had two shutouts. Mark Portugal won ten games while former Number One draft pick, reliever Wayne Gomes was a nine-game winner. The staff ERA was 4.64...On Opening Day at Shea Stadium, the Phils and Mets engaged in the longest opener in N.L. history, a fourteen inning contest the Mets won, 1-0...The Phils were 4-8 versus NL East champ, Atlanta, and finished the year 31 games behind the Braves.
