**Team leaders: Mike Marshall (21 homers, 65 RBI); Pete Guerrero (16 home runs, 72 RBI, 162 base hits, 85 runs scored, 29 doubles); Bob Welch (13 wins, 126 strikeouts); Fernando Valenzuela (12 wins, 240 strikeouts, 12 complete games). Alejandro Pena was a 12-game winner; Orel Hershisier won 11 games; and lefty Rick Honeycutt was a winner of ten contests. The Dodger pitching staff led the National League with 39 complete games and finished second with 13 shutouts. The staff ERA was 3.17 (2<sup>nd</sup> in the N.L.) with a league leading 1,033 strikeouts. They also allowed the fewest home runs (76)...Dodger batters hit 102 home runs and .244 at the plate for the season...They trailed the NL West champ Padres by 13 games at the end of the schedule, but were victors in ten of eighteen games with San Diego. The Dodgers (no surprise) led the N.L. in attendance at just over 3.13 million...A pair of Dodger greats, both in the Hall of Fame and broadcasters after they ended their careers on the diamond, were honored in '84 by having their numbers retired. "The Captain," Harold "Pee Wee" Reese (#1) and "Big D," Don Drysdale (#53), both highly-beloved by Dodger fans, will not have their uniform numbers worn by a Dodger again... "Candy" Maldonado's birth name is Candido.**
