Carmelo Martinez knocked in 72 runs and was the team leader after belting 21 homers. Steve Garvey followed with 17 dingers and drove home 81 runs to lead the ball club. Graig Nettles and Kevin McReynolds both hit 15 homers. Tony Gwynn was the leader in hits (197) and runs scored (90). The Padres hit .255 and 109 home runs for the year...Andy Hawkins was the top winner on the pitching staff with an 18-8 W/L record. LaMarr "Dewey" Hoyt was 16-8 and the All Star Game MVP. He had eight complete games. Lefty Dave Dravecky won 13 games and completed seven while Eric Show was a 12-game winner whose 141 strikeouts led the staff. Padres' hurlers finished the season fourth in the N.L. with a 3.40 ERA and 26 complete games which includes ten shutouts, third in the league. Closer Rich Gossage struck out 52 batters...The National League won the 56th All Star Game, 6-1. Hoyt was the N.L. starting pitcher going the first three innings giving up two hits and an unearned run. He walked none, struck out none, and was the game's winning pitcher...The defending National League Champions finished the year in a tie with the Astros 12 games in back of the Dodgers who won the NL West. San Diego WON the season series versus L. A., 10-8. They were 12-6 against Houston...Pitcher Eric Show's last name is pronounced like sHOW.
